She meets her cousins and her grandmother, Mimi, and she works with them in the family business, a small hotel. At the lake, some people are rich, but others, like her mother's family, aren't rich. Emma makes friends with a boy called Roo and learns secrets\* about her mother and father. This helps her understand who she is.

This is a story about families and love, and it's a great book for the summer holidays. Sarah Dessen understands teenagers very well and I like all her books. I recommend you read it!
