



Arboreal animals and plants



Next time you go to a forest, remember that one tree can be the home of many mammals, insects, birds and different types of plants and fungus.



This is mistletoe. It grows on tree branches. The plant is a parasite. It takes water and nutrients from the tree. But mistletoe is important because many birds and animals eat it.

This bird is called a woodpecker because it pecks tree trunks. It makes holes in the trunk. Its babies live in the hole. Woodpeckers eat insects that live in trees.

> These beetles lay their eggs in dead trees. When the larvae are born, they eat the dead wood.



Some mushrooms grow on tree trunks, but don't eat them. Some of them are poisonous.


When we cut down trees and forests, we destroy the natural habitat of many animals and plants.


