Before class:

Lesson Plans explain the basic structure of each type of lesson in the unit and how each type of lesson works, *e.g. the vocabulary lessons*. They also explain the **routines** which are the activities that you find in every unit, *e.g. the unit opener*.

Lesson Notes are detailed notes on the activities that are specific to each lesson.

Teacher Tips are also included in the lesson notes for most lessons, with helpful ideas on *Classroom Management, Communication and Socio-Emotional Learning.*

After class:

The Teacher Reflection Plan offers you the chance to reflect at the end of each class and evaluate what is working well with your students and what might be improved.

Ideas for sharing are also included so that you can set up a Teachers' Share It! program with other teachers in your school, to help and learn from each other.
