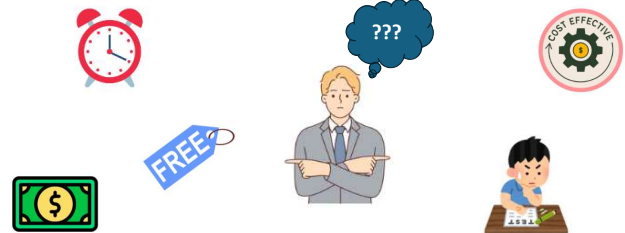

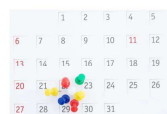
Effective Continuous Professional Development

What are my learning needs?

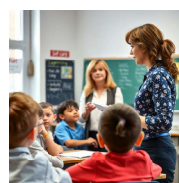
- Students' needs

INSPIRE: In-practice

What activities do I need to implement for my students?

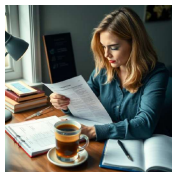

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QUESTION TO ASK YOURSELF!

How can I make my students' learning and my own learning visible?

Do I need to gather any information, and if so, how am I going to collect it?
