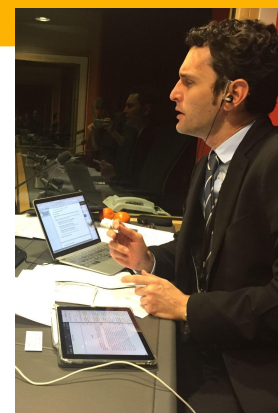

ChatGPT
Subtitles and captions serve similar purposes but are designed for different audiences:

- **Subtitles** are intended primarily for viewers who do not understand the language being spoken in the video. They translate the spoken dialogue into the viewer's language, allowing them to follow along with the action. Subtitles assume that the viewer can hear the audio and, therefore, typically do not include descriptions of non-speech elements such as sound effects or the identity of who is speaking if it's visually obvious.
- **Captions**, on the other hand, are designed for viewers who are deaf or hard of hearing. This means they not only transcribe the spoken dialogue but also include descriptions of important non-dialogue audio cues (like sound effects, music, and other significant audio events) and identifiers for who is speaking.
