AUDITORY LEARNER

Auditory learners learn best by listening. They might listen to a recording or podcast about the topic, or study with someone else to ask them questions.

- Make a recording of revision notes to listen back
- Hold a revision question & answer session with a friend
- Act out revision notes as a role-play
- Listen to a podcast on the subject

VISUAL LEARNER

Visual learners learn best by seeing things. They might look at charts or graphics, watch a relevant video clip, or read about the subject.

- Rewrite revision notes out in different coloured pens
- Watch a related video clip online
- Change the format of revision notes to fit a table, pie chart, bar chart or graph.
- ► Reread the text/book

KINAESTHETIC LEARNER

Kinaesthetic learners learn best by movement and touch, or by making learning into a memorable experience. They might use colour to highlight their notes, or act out a poem, story, or idea to help them to remember.

- Rewrite revision notes out in different coloured pens
- Act out revision notes as a role-play
- Change the format of revision notes to fit a table, pie chart, bar chart or graph.
- Create a rhyme or mnemonic to prompt memory
