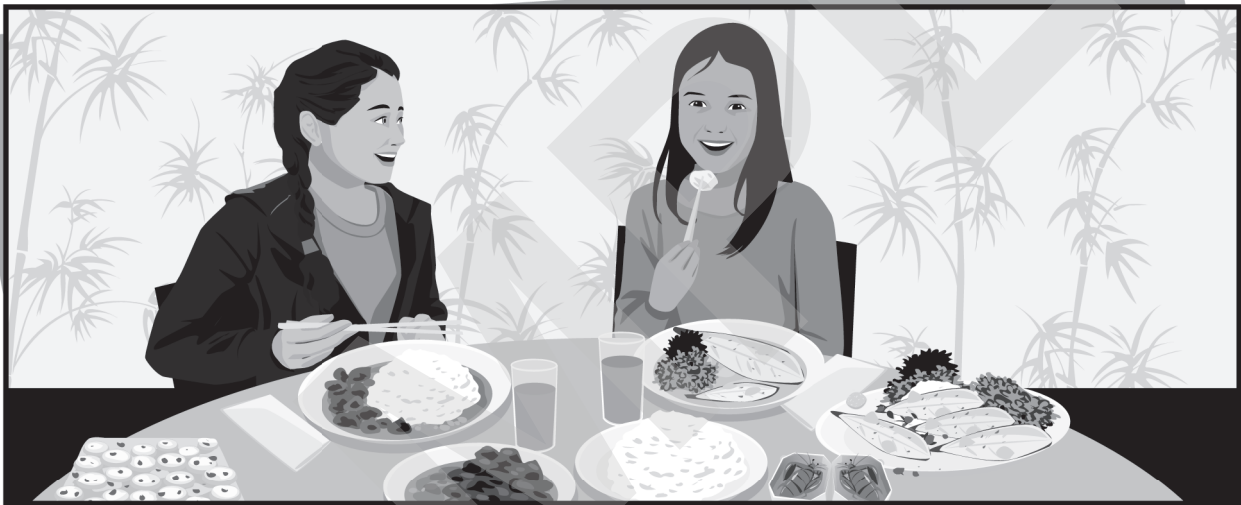

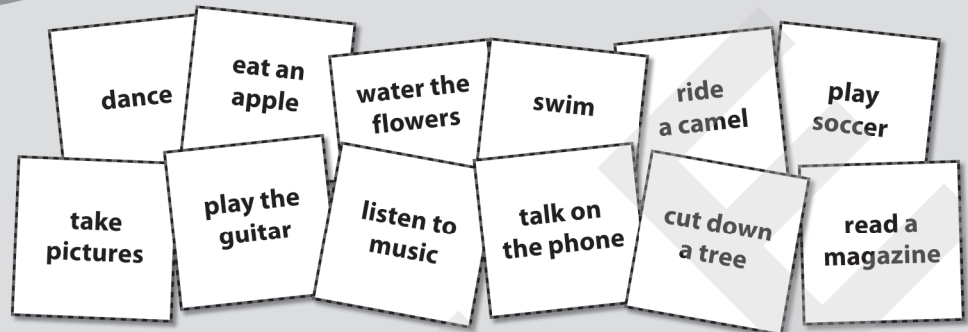

- 1 Play in groups of three.
- 2 Place the cards face down on the desk.
- 3 Two students (A and B) take one card.
- 4 Student C turns around while A and B act the verb. Student C counts to five and then says *Stop*. A and B stop and stand still like statues.
- 5 Student C can ask three questions, e.g. *Were you dancing?* Students A and B answer: *Yes, we were.* / *No, we weren't.*
