### New vocabulary for 2020 B1 Preliminary (for Schools)

**A:** acceptable, achievement, affect, ages, app, approximately, as long as, assist, astronaut, awesome

**B:** barber, bestseller

**C:** comment

**D:** discovery

**E:** enjoyable, enquire, even thought

**F:** focus on/upon sth/sb, frequently

**G:** goodbye, good evening, good night, goods

**H:** hike

**I:** ice skates, identify, ignore, impressed, incredibly, influence, inspire

**L:** luckily

**M:** mall, measure, monster, motorcycle

**N:** neither

**O:** occasionally

**P:** particularly, perfectly, pitch, presenter, production, prohibited

**Q:** quietly

**R:** react, relieved, rely (on), robot, robot, rope

**S:** selfie, sign up, slightly, smartphone, social media, soundtrack, spaceship, species, step forward/back (wards)/out, step over/in/out of (sth), superhero, supply
