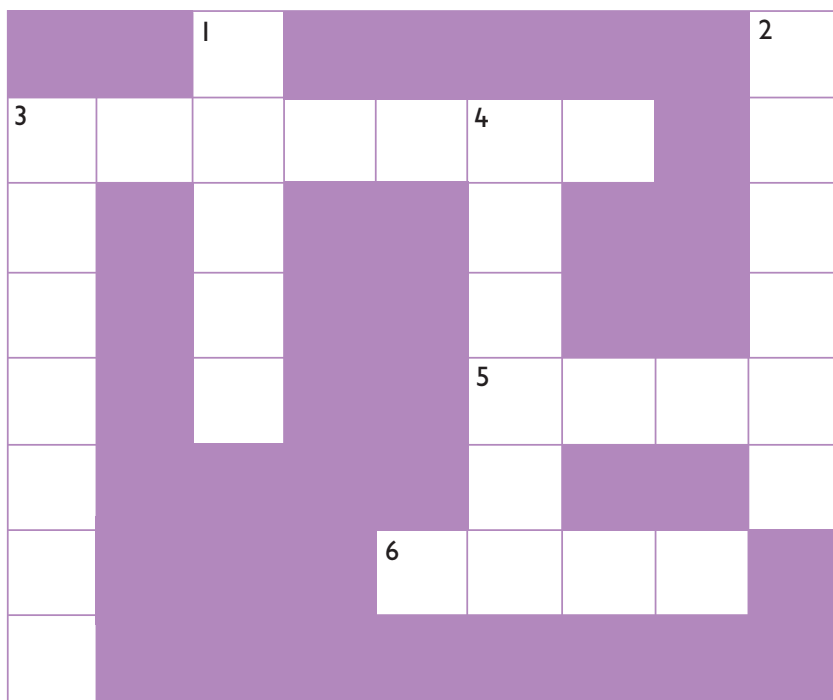
- 3 Circle the animals in the illustration that aren't in the poem.
