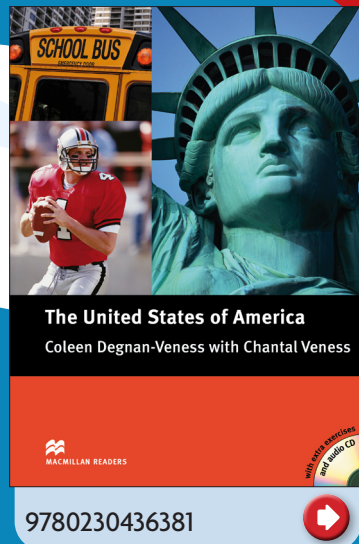
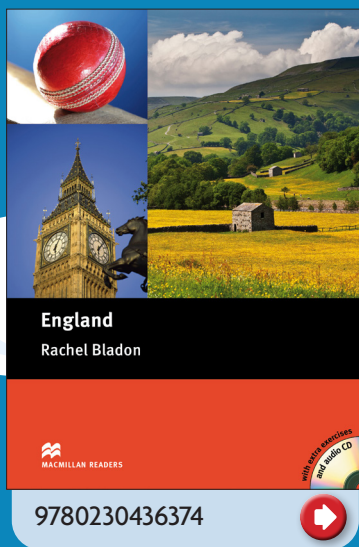


## RECOMMENDED READERS

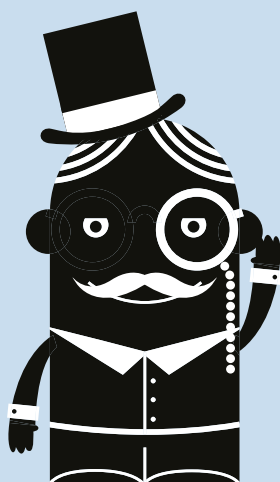
