Phonics practice activity

Ask the children to repeat: *Oh, boy! What a toy! What joy! Please enjoy!*

Follow-up activity

Ask the children to work in pairs to write a short dialogue. The dialogue should be about a well-known character or celebrity (e.g. Batman), and must include the grammar structures from unit 15: e.g. *Batman, whose car is this? It is mine.* Write these on the board to help the children. Give them about ten minutes to write the dialogue. Monitor, checking that they are setting out the dialogue correctly. Then ask two or three pairs to perform their dialogue to the class.
